After the presentation by Wayne Mullin, John Bosma, Jayme Campbell, Valerie Worrell and Murray Baillie, members agreed by vote to the following: to extend a call to Rev. Eunkyui Ji effective October 3, 2022 as per the terms that were outlined in the report; to request that Fundy St. Lawrence Dawning Waters Regional Council approve this call, and that the search team be disbanded, with our sincere thanks, following the covenanting service.

If you have any questions or wish to see the report, please request this from Wayne Mullin. More information will be forthcoming about how we are going to welcome Rev. Eunkyui Ji into our community, so please think about this over the next few weeks. Please pray for Rev. Eunkyui Ji and for all of us as a community of faith that we open our hearts and minds to each other's ministry as we begin this new pastoral relationship.
